Position Summary

The EMS Instructor plays an integral role in delivering our EMS Academy Courses at GoRescue Brands, Inc. The EMS Instructor is a part-time position that facilitates hands-on classroom learning and ensures students are engaged in high-quality EMS education, skills labs, and clinical rotations that meet and exceed state, national, and program standards. This position is for the EMT program.

Minimum Requirements

The ideal candidate should have the following:

- Deeply passionate about fulfilling the mission, vision, and values of company as well as eager to train the next generation of EMS professionals
- At least three (3) years of EMS patient care experience
- Current certification and license by the State of Alabama as an EMT, AEMT, or Paramedic
- Current certification by NREMT
- Current AHA BLS Instructor certification
- Certification from an EMS Instructor Course (at least one of the following):
 - Level 1 National Association of Emergency Medical Services Educators
 - Department of Transportation Instructor Course
 - Alabama Fire College Instructor Course
 - Department of Defense Instructor Course
 - AHA Core Instructor Course
- High school diploma
- Current Alabama Driver's License
- Associates degree or higher (preferred)
- Experience teaching EMT curriculum (highly preferred)
- Background in teaching, coaching, educating, or training (highly preferred)
- Excellent communication and presentation skills, including ability to effectively operate technology, training equipment, and other classroom / EMS equipment
- Must be able to effectively teach and administer all aspects of EMT program curriculum, including didactic, skills, labs, and evaluations
- Must be able to teach for extended periods of time with regularly scheduled 12hour teaching days while maintaining an engaging learning environment

Duties & Responsibilities

Reporting

The EMS Instructor reports directly to the EMS Academy Coordinator. There are no subordinates to this position.

Work Schedule

The EMS Instructor will complete all work assignments at the GoRescue EMS Academy Training Center in Birmingham, AL, during assigned hours. EMS Instructors will arrive at least thirty (30) minutes prior to the course start time to ensure all equipment, technology, facilities, and materials are prepared for course delivery. Work schedules may vary, but are typically as follows:

- 8AM-8PM during the Accelerated 16-Day EMT Program
- 5PM-9:30PM M-F, and 8AM-8PM Saturdays/Sundays during the Accelerated 30-Day EMT Program
- Instructor Development / Preparation Hours as assigned

EMS Instructors may be assigned as needed and agreed upon by the EMS Academy Coordinator. These assignments may be scheduled around the instructor's employment, including rotating shifts at public safety agencies, etc.

Compensation

The positional compensation plan is as a W-2 HOURLY EMPLOYEE as follows:

- Competitive hourly compensation:
 - EMS Grade 1, Step 1 = \$25/hr (for instructors with EMT certification)
 - EMS Grade 1, Step 2 = \$27.50/hr (for instructors with AEMT certification)
 - EMS Grade 1, Step 3 = \$30/hr (for instructors with Paramedic certification)
- \$25 per teaching day meal allowance for 12-hour teaching assignments, \$15 per teaching day for less than 12-hour teaching assignments
- Referral Incentive paid for new student referrals into the program
